



Vehicle Test and Certification Programme (VTCP)

Introduction

Lodi can provide a range of services designed to improve the roadworthiness of vehicles whilst ensuring compliance with road traffic legislation and required standards. Lodi will work with the the relevant local Authorities to provide modern and efficient services tailored to meet local needs and priorities.

Lodi's VTCP programme will ensure that heavy goods vehicles, buses, coaches, cars and motorbikes are maintained to a minimum legal standard through an annual Inspection and Certification process. Where necessary and desired, Lodi can work with the relevant Government Authority to establish required standards of roadworthiness against which vehicles will be tested and certificated. Lodi's VTCP is based on the UK Government VOSA system

For optimum control, Lodi's suggests the introduction of the Programme to Government owned and Public Service vehicles as an initial step before rolling it out to commercial fleets and the general public.

Programme Management

Lodi will apply their proven project management experience and systems to ensure the programme is delivered on time and to specification. The Programme elements will include:

- A number of specialist facilities specified by the customer organisation
- A skilled and trained team of inspectors, administrators and management
- Dedicated administration and systems
- A training facility

Lodi would propose to establish a central facility initially providing a full range of services and the central systems and administration hub. Following the successful launch of this facility, a roll-out programme would be initiated in line with Government priorities. The VTCP centres may be government or privately owned, operating on a license basis.

Skilled Resources - People Management and Training

A sound recruitment process and provision of a certificated training school will ensure specialist skills are acquired and maintained. Disciplines and processes would be implemented by the management to ensure standards of inspection, quality and integrity are maintained.

Systems

Effective systems will provide the platform on which the successful VCTP is built. There are two optional routes to suit local communication facilities and skills:

- All hand paper work and final document loaded into a computer system for back up.
- All work managed and controlled using computer systems

Systematic and numerical recording of documentation combined with routine auditing and spot-checks will prevent errors and maintain standards of efficiency.
